



Cancer information

For the first medical exam after the diagnosis of a cancer, the FAA will want the following information:

- Operative report
- Biopsy report
- Letter from the patient's treating doctor detailing:
 - (a) Presence or absence of metastases
 - (b) Current tumor marker levels (PSA, CEA)
 - (c) Treatment plan and whether or not it is complete
 - (d) Frequency of follow-up visits
 - (e) Statement regarding whether or not the patient is considered cured or in total/full remission

For subsequent exams, the FAA will want the letter from the treating doctor with the above information **listed A-E**.

The letter should reference:

- Pilot's Name
- Pilot's Social Security Number
- Date of Flight Physical
